6) How are the stories of Zechariah and Mary similar and different?

Read v18 & v38

7) Are you currently responding to God's Word more like Mary or Zechariah? How regularly are you feeding on God's Word?

8) Are you willing to obey anything the Bible clearly says to do, whether you like it or not? What are the challenges with this?

9) Are you willing to trust God in anything he sends into your life, whether you understand it or not? When is this difficult to do in practice?

10) Spend some time worshipping Jesus as God's King who came to establish His everlasting Kingdom.
