## CONNECT WITH THE MESSAGE

Here are some follow-up questions to help you get the most out of today's Bible Message.

If you're in a Small Group, it would be helpful to look through it beforehand and note down a few thoughts.



### Courage (1 Chronicles 28:20)

- 1) What was the most helpful or challenging part of Sunday's message for you? Why?
- 2) If you had a son or daughter, what advice would give them in relation to courage? How well are you living your own advice?
- 3) What would you do if you had no fear?

4) Talk about a time when you felt fear and chose to be courageous or to be afraid?

5) If 'God with us' is the antidote to fear, how do you intentionally turn your eyes onto him? How do the Bible, prayer and worship help with this?

6) Who could you encourage to be more courageous and less fearful this week and how might you do this?

#### **PRAY**

- thank God that he is with you and in you through the Holy Spirit.
- thank God for the courage of Jesus, suffering and dying for us.
- for courage to live faithfully for Jesus and be a witness for him, no matter what people think or say.

### **Taking It Further**

#### **Read 1 Peter 3:8-17**

1) From these verses, how should we be living as Christians?

2) What might make us fearful to do good and speak to people about the hope Jesus gives us?

3) What does it mean to 'in your heart set apart (or revere) Christ as Lord' (v15)? How does this help when we are afraid?

## **CONNECT IN PRAYER**

### **Easter Outreach Events**

- Pray this Easter would be a fantastic time for us to celebrate and reflect on the death and resurrection of Jesus to give us new life with God.
- Pray about who you could invite to the Family 'Eggstravanga' or the Easter Sunday Guest Service.
- Pray for our Community Choir as they rehearse for their Good Friday Concert and invite family and friends. Pray it would be well attended and for God to use the concert to connect people with the church and draw them to Jesus.
- Pray that people who have been to other events, like at Christmas and the Quiz Night, might come at back at Easter and begin exploring Jesus.
- Pray that people might receive new life through Jesus this Easter.
