CONNECT WITH THE MESSAGE

Here are some follow-up questions to help you get the most out of today's Bible Message.

If you're in a Small Group, it would be helpful to look through it beforehand and note down a few thoughts.



We are a Growing Church (Ephesians 4:7-16)

- 1) What do you think was most important thing from Sunday's message? In what way has it inspired or challenged you?
- 2) Why is it important to grasp that Jesus has given gifts to all of us? How might you need to value your own gifts as well as other people's?
- 3) How does the idea that leaders are gifts to equip the church, fit with alternative views you have come across about church leaders?

4) How have you benefited from the types of leaders mentioned in v11 and how can you value them more or benefit more from them?

5) What part could you play in our church growing towards maturity? How does maturity relate to our mission to be a City on a Hill?

PRAY

- Thank God for all the gifts God has given to our church, in every member but also through the leaders and those who work with us.
- Pray for us to value every gift, for them to grow and develop and that we would be fully equipped to serve God, each other and those who need Jesus.
- Pray for a greater maturity in our church, a deeper love and a firmer grasp of the truth of God's word as we grow to be more and more like Jesus.

3) What should our response be to God when facing trials in life?

4) What sort of person won't benefit from the trials of life and how can we make sure we are not like them?
