Come and be encouraged by stories of God at work, as well as to seek God as we worship and bring our requests before our loving and mighty Father in Heaven.

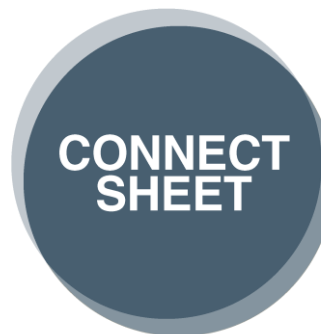

Here are some follow-up questions to help you get the most out of today's Bible Message. If you're in a Core Connect Group, it would be helpful to read them before you meet and note down your thoughts.

God with Us: Conflict (Romans 12:17-18)

- 1) What are your recent experiences of relational difficulties or conflict?
- 2) What was the most challenging thing for you personally from the message on Sunday?
- 3) How do you think 'living at peace with everyone' is different to just 'being nice to people'?

4) Why do you think the Bible places such a high value on good relationships between Christians?

5) How could you build or strengthen good relationships with others in our church?

6) How do you try to handle the tension between 'living at peace' with people and sharing the gospel with them?

PRAY

- Thank God for Jesus making possible reconciliation between you and God
- Ask God to show you ways in which you can bring peace and harmony into your relationships with others
- Ask God to bring to mind anyone you need to forgive or to ask for forgiveness – then do it!

Going Further

Read **Luke 12:49-59**

- 1) What does Jesus mean when he says he has come to bring division not peace?
- 2) Why does Jesus apparently want families to be divided?
- 3) How does this affect how we understand Romans 12v18?
- 4) What are the personal challenges for you from these verses?
