# Read Matthew 12:33-37 5) What is similar about what Jesus and James say? 6) What does Jesus say lies behind what we speak: good or bad? 7) What do you think Jesus would say is the way to deal with wrong speech? 8) List some different ways we can speak 'careless words'. 9) How do v36-37 make the same point as James 2:17-18 that we looked at last week? 10) Which aspects of your speech do you need to confess to God and then ask for his grace?

## DIGGING DEEPER

#### Read Psalm 34

- a) Which good uses of speech are mentioned in this Psalm?
- b) How does it work in practice to have the Lord's praise always on your lips?
- c) When do you exalt God's name together with other Christians? (v3)
- d) Why is this important? Why not just do this on your own?
- e) When did you last speak to God to call out to him in trouble? (v6,v17)
- f) Has your experience been anything like David's when you did this? (v4-7, v17-22)
- g) How does God fulfill these promises to us, even when life is still tough?
- h) What does David say about misuse of the tongue?
- i) Should a New Covenant believer (you) expect the blessings that David talks about under the Old Covenant for keeping your tongue from evil? (v12)
- j) What is the similarity to the command in Ephesians 6:1-3 and how does it help us?
- k) Speak to God about your desire to have a tongue and lips that honour him.
