

Wait Patiently

James 5:7-11

1) When was the last time you had to wait patiently for something? How did you do?



Read James 5:7 – 11

2) What was the most relevant thing for you in the Sunday message from these verses?

3) How have you seen impatience in the face of suffering affect how people treat one another?

4) Why should remembering the return of Jesus help us wait patiently now?

Read Matthew 24:42-51

5) What does Jesus want us to know about the timing of his return?

6) How can we 'be ready' for it as he says in v44?

7) What might be the effect on how we live, and how we treat others, when we are not expecting our Master to return?

Read Matthew 25:14-30

8) Which detail in this parable (and the previous passage) might hint that Jesus was not going to return immediately?

9) From this parable, what does a God-centred life look like as we wait for Jesus to return?

10) Where in your life is God calling you to be faithful and patient with a small amount?

DIGGING DEEPER

Read Psalm 37

a) How does this Psalm have a similar message to James 5:7-11?

b) Why do you think the believers in this Psalm are also described as the 'poor and needy'? (v14, v16)

c) Why might this frequently be the case in the Bible, but with exceptions?

d) What sort of suffering of God's people is described in this Psalm? (e.g. v12, v19)

e) What forms might it take for a Christian today?

f) Which expressions are used in this Psalm to describe patient and faithful waiting for God?

g) Which of these is God speaking to you about for your own life?

h) Reading this Psalm as a Christian, which promises do we now know will be ultimately fulfilled at the return of Jesus and in the eternal rest in him?
i) Spend some time praising God for the encouragements of Ps 37 and for his help to live in the light of its promises.
