Loving the Peace

James 3:13-4:3

1) What do you like doing in your spare time to get some peace or to unwind?



Read James 3:13 - 4:3

2) What did you find most helpful about Jeff's message?

3) From the 8 attributes of a wise life in verse 17, which of these do you find most challenging to live out and why?

Read Proverbs 3:13-18

4) Spend some time with God to ask for more wisdom (see also James 1:5) so that you can live in peace with others – note what it says in verse 17.

Read Philippians 4:4-9

5) What does this tell us about the peace of God?

7) Are you seeing these results or do you have struggles with envy?

Read Romans 12:18

8) On a scale from 1 to 10, do you feel your relationships at church show peace-making (and therefore true wisdom) or conflict (10 being ultimate peace-making)?

Read Acts 9:31

9) What was the result of the church being at peace?

10) What action could you take to ensure that we see similar results at King's?

11) Who do you know outside of church who needs the peace of God in their situation? Spend some time praying for that person.

DIGGING DEEPER

Read Ephesians 2

a) In verses 1-9 make a list of what God has done for us and the impact on our position.

b) What's the expectation in verse 10 and how do you think this is working in your life?

c) From verses 14-18 what is the clear intention of God for his people?

d) What image does Paul use for the church in verses 19-22?

e) How could this help you in your day to day relationships in church life?

Read Ephesians 4:1-5

f) In what ways does Paul encourage us to live out our God-centred lives?

g) How are you doing in these areas?

h) Spend some time praying about the areas you find most difficult.

i) Bring to God any areas of conflict and unforgiveness with others in church life where peace is not reigning.

j) Spend time praying for those in your group who need God's peace about a particular life situation.
