

7) How does this passage help you to keep trusting God in difficult times?
Read 1 Peter 1:6-9 8) What reason does this passage give for us encountering 'all kinds of trials'?
9) What reason does it give that we can rejoice when we suffer?
10) How can suffering strengthen & refine our faith?

DIGGING DEEPER

Read 1 Peter 4:12-19

- a) What specific kind of 'trial' is Peter referring to in this passage?
- **b)** In what which are Christians participating in the sufferings of Christ in this type of trial?
- c) How does this participation give us a reason to rejoice in sufferings?
- d) Why do you think Christians are surprised when they suffer?
- e) Find and write down several verses from the New Testament that tell Christians they should expect to suffer in various ways?
- f) What does it mean for 'judgement to begin with the family of God'?
- g) How can suffering in this way strengthen our assurance of faith?
- h) What are we instructed to do in the face of this sort of suffering?
- i) How have you personally experienced this kind of trial? How did you respond?
- j) How can this passage help you when you next face difficult times?
