- f) How might this difficulty be resolved?
- g) How is the Holy Spirit a part of the blessings promised? What Old Testament passages does Paul have in mind?
- h) How does this passage shape your own self-identity & affect everyday life?
- i) How does this passage motivate you personally to practically be a conduit of blessing to others?
