1) What do you love about church?

3) What reasons would you give if someone asked you why it important for Christians to be part of a church?

Read Peter 2:9-12

4) What does this tell us about how Jesus feels about the church?

5) What two things are we called to do as a result?

6) Are there things that make it hard for you to be as involved with church as you would like?

7) What practically can you do to be involved despite these things? (Tip: ask others from the church for some ideas!)

Read Matthew 13:31-33

8) How would you explain these two parables in one sentence each?

9) How will you represent King's Church Lewes well this week?

10) What could you do to strengthen the church this week?

DIGGING DEEPER

Read 1 Peter 20:4-12

- a) Peter describes the church in terms of several Old Testament 'institutions'. What are they?
- b) For each one explain why it is appropriate to describe the church this way.
- c) In what ways does this passage help you to value the church?
- d) What is the Old Testament background for verses 9 and 10?
- e) What are the implications of verses 9 and 10 for a Christian's view of the nation of Israel? Why?
- f) What implications does Peter explicitly state for believers when the church is understood properly?
- g) How are you personally responding to these implications?
- h) How will you personally work to strengthen the church this week?
- i) Who is the stone(s) described in verses 6-8? Why is he described in this way?
