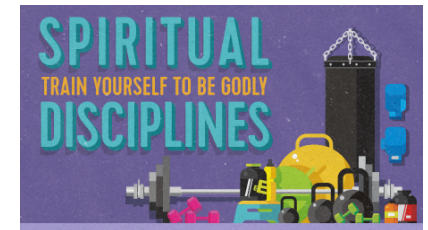

CONNECT WITH THE MESSAGE

The Bible

1) Jesus talked about how the Bible is spiritual food for us. But what is your favourite physical food?



Read Matthew 4:4

2) What did you find most helpful or challenging from Jack's sermon and why?

3) What reasons would you give someone as to why we should read the Bible?

Read Psalm 119:9-16

4) What does the Psalmist say are the benefits of not neglecting God's word?

Read 2 Timothy 3v12-17

- 5) What does Paul in this passage say the Bible is useful for?
- 6) What does Paul mean when describing the Scriptures as God breathed?
- 7) How does the Bible equip us for every good work?
- 8) Jack talked about the consistency of reading the Bible with a time, place and plan. What is consistent in your Bible reading? If it isn't, what could you do to change that?
- 9) Which creative ways do you read the Bible (or could you try reading the Bible)?
- 10) How does being part of a community help you reading your Bible, or could it help you? Who could you study the Scriptures with?

DIGGING DEEPER

Read Psalm 1

- a) Write a list of what the person who delights in the Law of the Lord is like.
- b) What is the person like who doesn't delight in the Law of the Lord?
- c) How often does the Psalmist say someone who delights in the Law of the Lord thinks about Scripture?
- d) What do you think that looks like?
- e) How could you help cultivate this kind of devotion to Scripture in your life?
- f) What does it mean by "whatever they do prospers?"
Does that mean life is perfect if you read your Bible?
- g) What do you think the Psalmist means by the term "blessed"?
- h) In what way is a person delighting in God's law like a tree? (v3)
- i) In what ways are the wicked like chaff? (v4-6)
- j) How do these two different images motivate you to delight in God's word?

CONNECT IN PRAYER

Bonfire Night & the Persecuted Church

- Pray for an enjoyable Bonfire Night in Lewes for all attending & taking part

- Pray for the renewal and revival of churches in Zhejiang province, which had their buildings demolished and crosses torn down last year.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to bring a spirit not of timidity and fear, but of power and courage to Christians in China.
