3) What, if anything, does this parable teach us about generosity?

Read Proverbs 11:25 and 22:9 and Psalm 112:5

4) What consequences of generosity are given in these verses?

5) Are they always true? If so how? If not, why not?

6) In light of your answers to Q5, how do these verses inspire you to greater generosity?

Read Romans 12:6-8

7) What do you think a gift of “giving” is?

8) How would someone know if they had a gift of giving?
