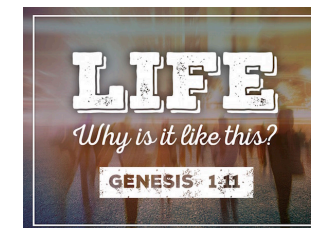

Be Like God

Genesis 3:1-6

1) What's your favourite fruit?



Read Genesis 3:1-6

2) How if at all, has Rich's message helped you think about sin?

Read Matthew 4:1-11

3) What were the three ways the devil tempted Jesus?

4) How did Jesus respond each time?

5) What can this teach us about resisting temptation ourselves?

6) In which areas of life do you find yourself vulnerable to temptation?

7) Can you find some specific Bible verses to help you fight temptation in those areas? (Memorising some of them would be a good idea)

Read 1 Corinthians 10:12-13

8) How could these verses help you when facing temptation?

Read James 1:13-15

9) What is the 'slippery slope' into sin described in this passage?

10) In which ways does this passage repeat the message of Genesis 3:1-6?

DIGGING DEEPER

Read Romans 5:12-21

- a) How does this passage say sin and death came into the world?
- b) Is sin more than just breaking a command? Why?
- c) How is Adam portrayed as "a pattern of the one to come"? (v14)
- d) How does this passage compare and contrast Adam and Jesus?
- e) Do you think "all people" in v18 means every person who has lived? Why?
- f) What specifically about Jesus enabled him to make many righteous? (v19)
- g) Does this passage encourage us to read Genesis 3 as about Adam or about us? Why?
- h) Why does this passage say God gave the Old Testament law to Israel?
- i) How do your personal achievements affect your standing before God?
- j) In which ways does this passage help you when you face temptation?

CONNECT IN PRAYER

Catalyst Festival

- Pray that time spent together would result in stronger friendships and contribute to the overall sense of community in our whole church.
- Pray that as we gather together to worship Jesus, hear from the Bible and receive through one another's gifts that we would get caught up in the bigger picture of what God is doing.
