

Remembered & Reassured

Genesis 8:1-22

1) What's the most embarrassing thing you've ever forgotten?

Read Genesis 8:1-22

2) What was particularly helpful, encouraging or challenging from Al's message from this passage on Sunday?

3) Have you ever felt as though God had forgotten you?

4) What would you say to encourage a Christian who was feeling this way?

5) How did Noah act with obedience to God's instructions and when did he simply act with wisdom?
6) Do you have a tendency to try to live more by obedience or more by wisdom? Why does God want us to respond to him with both?
7) What was the first thing Noah did after leaving the ark?
8) Why did he do this?
9) Have you ever forgotten to thank God for something he has done for you? What could help you to be more thankful?
10) Give thanks to God for remembering and rescuing you, in Jesus but also in everyday life.

DIGGING DEEPER

Read Psalm 13:1-6

- a) What sort of situation prompted David to write this Psalm?
- b) How does it make him feel towards God?
- c) What questions does he ask God?
- d) What, if anything, has ever made you feel this way?
- e) What does he ask God to do for him?
- f) Do you think the situation has been resolved at the end of the Psalm?
- g) How does v5 and v6 fit with v1 and v2?
- h) What does this Psalm teach you about God and about yourself?
- i) Pray through the Psalm applying it to any situations you face, large or small.
