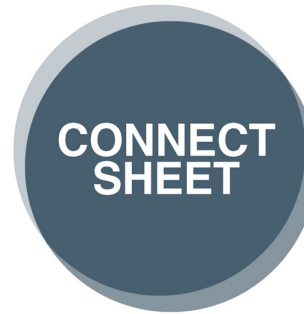

Here are some follow-up questions to help you get the most out of today's Bible Message. If you're in a Core Connect Group, it would be helpful to read them before you meet and note down your thoughts.



Unstealable Joy (John 16:16-33)

- 1) Apart from God, what gives you the most joy in life?

- 2) What experiences have you had of joy that didn't last or was very much based on your outward circumstances?

- 3) What do you most remember from the message on Sunday?



4) How well does Jesus' promise of joy that no-one can take away fit with your experience as a Christian?

5) What is so good about knowing that we are children of God and God is our Father?

6) What would help you to grasp the love of the Father more and allow his joy to underpin your life?

PRAY

- Thank God for his great love for us and making us his children through Jesus' death and resurrection.
- Pray that you might know more of the Father's love for you, deep in your heart and that would give you joy in all circumstances.
- Pray that non-Christians would notice your joy and that you would opportunities to recommend Jesus to others.

Going Further

Read Galatians 5:16-26

- 1) Joy is part of the fruit of the Spirit. Why do you think joy and the other 8 characteristics are described as fruit of Spirit?
- 2) What is the conflict described in this Bible passage?
- 3) How do we hold together the idea that we need to choose (and fight) to live by the Spirit with the idea that the fruit of the Spirit comes naturally?
- 4) What can you do to grow in joy, along with the other fruit?
