2) What did you find most helpful or challenging from Al's message on Sunday?

4) Where would you most like see the light of Jesus make an impact?

5) How and where would could you pray for the peace of the Prince of Peace to come this Christmas? How might God want to use you?

6) Why do you think the shepherds were the first to hear about the birth of Jesus?

7) What are the key points of the angel's message to the shepherds?

8) Which of those points would you like God to help you grasp more fully this Christmas?

9) What did the shepherds do after seeing Jesus for themselves? How can this inspire us?

10) Thank God for the good news of Jesus at Christmas and pray for those you'd like to share it with.

Read Colossians 1:15-23

- 1) List some of the different ways that the Son is image of the invisible God?
- 2) How do we see this demonstrated in the life of Jesus on earth?
- 3) How do v15-17 make it seem all the more amazing that the Son was born as a tiny human baby and laid in a manger?
- 4) In what ways do the majority of people in the world around us misunderstand and underestimate Jesus?
- 5) What key verses and truths from v15-20 about Jesus would you love to show someone who is not yet a Christian?
- 6) What do v20-23 teach us about the Peace on Earth which the angels announced to the shepherds (Luke 2:14) and how it is possible?
- 7) Worship and rejoice in God for his Son and his initiative in our reconciliation.
