8) Can we expect an "easy" life as a Christian?
9) How does the testimony of Peter and John help you cope with the idea of bearing your cross and being subject to persecution?
10) Spend some time in prayer like the disciples in Acts. Including asking God to reveal new ways in which you can bear your cross.
