1) If you could change one thing about your character what would it be? Why?

4) What does a 'Revolutional Life' look like

1 Peter 1:13-22

5) How would you describe 'Holiness' to someone who is not a Christian?

6) In what areas do you personally need to grow in holiness?

7) Find at least three reasons Peter gives for us to 'be holy' in this passage.

8) How could you connect more with people who are not Christians and show them the difference Jesus makes?

9) Pray for God to help you be a positive influence for Jesus amongst non-Christians.

DIGGING DEEPER

Read 1 Samuel 15:1-35

- 1) Why does Samuel instruct Saul to be so ruthless towards the Amalekites?
- 2) What problems/concerns do you have with Samuel's instructions?
- 3) What relevance does this command have for Christians today? What does it definitely not mean today?
- 4) What reasons does Saul give for failing to obey fully?
- 5) How does Saul try to convince Samuel (and himself?) that he has really fully obeyed?
- 6) Are there areas of your life where you are only partially obeying God? Why do you think that is?
- 7) How does this passage point forward to Jesus?
- 8) Pray and ask God to show you ways in which you are not fully obeying God, without realising it.
