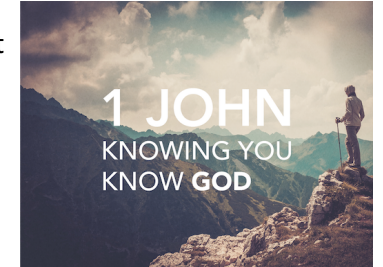

CONNECT WITH THE MESSAGE

Knowing Because You Have The Spirit

1 John 4:1-6

1) Have you recently doubted the truth of what someone said to you? What made you unsure?



Read 1 John 4:1-6

2) What did you find most encouraging or challenging from the message on Sunday?

3) How likely do you think it is that you would come across a false prophet or teacher, either inside our church or outside? Do you think you ever have?

4) What might alert you that there was a problem with what this person was saying or writing about God? What would you do about it?

5) Why does John focus on what false (or true) teachers say about Jesus?

6) What other tests of false teaching/teachers does John give in his letter?
What's to stop us calling everyone a false teacher who we don't agree with?

Read John 10:1-21

7) Who do the shepherd, the sheep and the stranger/thief/robber represent?

8) What does Jesus teach about Christians recognising his voice and being wary of those telling lies?

9) How does the Holy Spirit reassure us that we are real Christians and enable us to recognise and believe God's truth?

10) Spend some time praying: for those who teach in our church; that you would keep believing and growing to know the truth of God's word in the Bible; for anyone you worry is being led astray or even leading others astray.
