Luke 6:46-49

1) What kinds of things do people try to use to give their life a solid foundation?



Read Luke 6:46-49

2) What was the most helpful part of the message on Sunday for you?

3) What practical steps could you take to hear more of God's word in the Bible?

4) How could you be involved in encouraging someone else in listening to God's word and doing what it says?

5) How do you get stuck, demotivated or stubborn when it comes to doing what God says in the Bible? How can the church help you with this and how you make the most of the support God provides in the church?

6) How might it work for non-Christians to see our foundations in the storms of life and be attracted to Jesus? Have you ever seen this happen?

7) How could you, together with our church, be better at helping lost people hear and obey God's word and know the solid foundation of Jesus.?

Read Psalm 1:1-6

8) What is similar about this Psalm and Jesus' parable of the two builders?

9) What does it add to the picture or say in a different way?

10) Pray about how you can listen to and obey God's word more. Pray that we help one another as a church to do that better. Pray we would help lost people back to God and the solid foundation of Jesus
