#### Gospel Perspective (Philippians 1:12-19)

1) What was the most helpful or challenging part of Sunday's message for you? Why?

2) In which part of your life do you struggle to see any Gospel opportunities?

3) What might you see with Gospel Glasses on and how might your Connect Group support you in this?

- 4) Who inspires you as a witness for Jesus and why?
- 5) Are there any recent successes or failures you have had in witnessing that you could share with your Group and that might encourage the others?
- 6) Where might you come across examples of Christians proclaiming Christ but in a wrong way? How can you have a Gospel Perspective on this?

#### **PRAY**

- Thank God for the spread of the Gospel which continues day by day.
- Pray for one another about seeing Gospel Opportunities everywhere and making the most of them.
- Pray to be encouraged and inspired by one another in this.
- Rejoice in Jesus and the Gospel being proclaimed by whoever.

### **Taking It Further**

#### Read Acts 28:16-31

This passage describes Paul under arrest in Rome, from where he most likely wrote to the Philippians.

- 1) How does he make the most of his situation for the Gospel?
- 2) How much effort did he make and how successful was he, judging by appearances?
- 3) How does Paul (and Luke the writer of Acts) seem to judge his faithfulness and success in witness?
