Here are some follow-up questions to help you get the most out of today's Bible Message.

Useful People (Philippians 2:19-30)

1) What part of Sunday's message did you find most helpful or challenging? Why?

- 2) Are there people who you personally find helpful examples of Christian living? What is it about them and how do you try to be like them?
- 3) In what ways are you a good and a bad example to other Christians?
- **4)** How much do you think we can develop the character traits Rich discussed ourselves and how much do we need God to do it for us? Why?

- 5) How does who Jesus is and what he has done helps you to live more like him?
- 6) In what situations do you find it hard to put other people first?

PRAY

- Thank God for Jesus as our ultimate example and the one who makes it possible for us to change
- Ask God to help you in the specific ways you'd like to be more like Jesus in your character
- Bring to God any situations where you find it hard to live consistently for him

Taking It Further

Read Philippians 2:14-18

- 1) What motivation does this passage give for living righteously?
- 2) What's the difference between 'grumbling and arguing' and simply disagreeing? How could you know when you've crossed the line?
- 3) How would 'grumbling and arguing' diminish the Philippians ability to 'shine like stars'?
- 4) Are there attitudes or behaviours that undermine your witness for Jesus? What are they and how can you deal with them?
- 5) What can you do this week to share God's light to 'a warped and crooked generation'?
