### Staying Safe (Philippians 3:1-11)

- 1) What was the most memorable or helpful part of Sunday's message for you?
- 2) Other than Jesus, what would you be most likely to trust in for acceptance before God? Why?
- 3) How does trusting in our own performance lead to pride or despair?
- 4) What is so good about trusting in Jesus alone to be right with God?

5) What are the three most precious things/people to you apart from Jesus and knowing him?

6) How could they ever compete with Jesus and what can you do about it?  
How can we help one another in this?

#### PRAY

- Thank God for Jesus, who he is, what he has done for us and for all that it means to know him as a Christian.
- Pray for renewed confidence to trust in Jesus as our righteousness.
- Pray that God would show you any rivals to Jesus in your life and how to keep him as No. 1.
- Pray about supporting and challenging one another in this.

### Taking It Further

Read Psalm 119:1-24

- 1) What do these verses tell us about the life priorities of the Psalmist?
- 2) Which particular verses speak of the Psalmist's desire for God?
- 3) What do these verses teach us about the relationship between reading the Bible and having Jesus as No. 1 in our lives?
- 4) How can you help someone else to prioritise and pursue knowing Jesus better?
- 5) What could you pray for them and for yourself?
