Stronger in Prayer 2 - All Kinds of Prayers

1) Where do you pray and what do you do and say most often when you pray?
2) Read Ephesians 6v18. Was there anything you found especially helpful from Al's talk on Sunday?
3) Read 1 Thessalonians 5v16-18 . How is it possible to 'pray continually'? (It's a similar idea to praying 'on all occasions' in Ephesians 6v18)
4) The Bible describes different ways we can pray on different occasions. What are the benefits of: i) Focused private prayer (read Matthew 6v6)
ii) Quick prayers on the go (read Nehemiah 2v1-8)
iii) Praying with other Christians (read Acts 4v13-31)
5) How has your relationship with God developed as you've prayed on different occasions?

DIGGING DEEPER

Read John 15v1-8

- a) What are the main things Jesus wants to understand from this whole picture of him as the vine and Christians as the branches (v5)
- b) Why is it so important to remain (or abide) in Jesus?
- c) How do we remain in Jesus? How does v7 help?
- d) What is the connection between Jesus' words remaining in us and having our prayers answered? (v7)
- e) Can you think of an example of how Jesus' words (and all of God's words in the Bible) have shaped and directed your prayers?
