In approx. 690BC Sennacherib King of Assyria invaded the kingdom of Judah and sent a threatening message to King Hezekiah in Jerusalem. Assyria was the dominant world superpower of the day with a vast empire and terrifying armies. Judah was a small, poorly armed mini-state.

- a) How does Hezekiah respond to the threatening letter?
- b) What do you think is the significance of Hezekiah's opening lines in verse 15?
- c) How is Hezekiah realistic about the strength of Assyrian power?
- d) How is Hezekiah realistic about God's ability to deliver?
- e) What reasons does Hezekiah give for God to rescue them?
- f) What can you learn from this prayer to help you pray 'hilltop prayers' for our church, our town and our nation?
- g) Ask the Holy Spirit to help you to be realistic but also full of faith.
