#### CONNECT WITH THE MESSAGE

Tough Question 10 - Hasn't science replaced faith?

1) What do you remember most about your science lessons at school?

Read Genesis 1v1. What question would you most like to ask having listened to Rich's message?

3) Read Genesis Chapter 1. Too often Christians spend so much time looking at exactly what Genesis chapter 1 might or might not mean scientifically, that they miss what it tells us theologically.

a) The challenge for this Bible Study is to see what these verses tell us regardless of our interpretation of the scientific questions.

i) What does verse 1 tell us about:

b) How does what you have found in this passage enlarge your view of God? In what ways does it help you to trust God more?

c) What would you say to a friend who isn't a Christian, who says that they don't believe the Bible because science has shown Genesis 1 to be wrong?

## **DIGGING DEEPER**

Read Romans 5v12-21. This passage draws parallels between Adam & Jesus.

- a) What does this passage tell us about the similarities between Jesus and Adam?
- b) What does this passage tell us about the *differences* between Jesus and Adam?
- c) How would this passage be affected by the view that Adam was not a real person?
- d) How does this passage contrast Adam's 'work' with Jesus's work?
- e) Do verses 18&19 teach that everyone will be saved? Why?
- f) How does this passage give us confidence in our relationship with God?
- g) How can you use this passage to inspire and motivate you in worship and your Christian life?
