Tough Question 11 - Isn't God sexist?

1) Have you ever encountered blatant sexual discrimination or harassment? How did you deal with it?
2) Read <b>Ephesians 5v22-24.</b> What do you think was the most important thing Rich said on Sunday? Why?
3) Read the rest of the passage <b>Ephesians 5v22-33</b> . a) What does this passage tell us about Jesus? What do you think we can learn from this passage about how Jesus feels about the church?
Read <b>Matthew 20v25-28.</b> b) What do these verses tell us about leadership? How did Jesus serve us?
c) Read John 6v38. i) Write down several specific ways/ occasions where you think Jesus submitted his will to the Father's will?
ii) In what ways/ on which occasions do you struggle to submit to God?
iii) In what ways/ on which occasions do you struggle to submit to people leading you? (eg: husbands, parents, church leaders, your boss etc)
iv) Do you think you should submit even when you disagree with leaders? Why?

## DIGGING DEEPER

Read **1 Corinthians 11v2-16.** This is a difficult passage to understand, however, there is a whole sermon on it in our 'Messy Church' series ('Play your position', **1 Corinthians 11v2-16**, 24<sup>th</sup> May 2009) available from the Media section of the website. This will give you some help if you need it.

- a) What do you think verse 3 means by the word 'head'?
- b) Why do think Paul seems to be concerned about women having their heads covered when praying or prophesying in Church? [See especially verses 5&10)?
- c) What does this passage tell us about the different roles of the husband and wife in marriage?
- d) What does this passage tell us about God?
- e) What does this passage tell us about Jesus?
- f) How could you personally live out the principles taught in this passage?
