iii) Are there things about God that are not shown to us by the universe and/or the things in it? If so, what do you think they are?

ii) In what ways do you think that people today reject/ignore the truth about God's existence?

<ul> <li>i) Verses 21-23 say that people who reject God unwisely swap God for other things.</li> <li>i) What do you think the 'images' in verse 23 were?</li> </ul>
ii) What things do you think people today look to instead of God? Why do you think people prefer these things to God?
iii) What can you do to help people you know reconnect with the real God?

iv) In what way do you personally look to other things instead of looking to God to meet your needs?

- a) Why does David say it is foolish to deny that God exists?
- b) How sympathetic do you think David is towards people with that view?
- c) What reasons/motives do you think this Psalm attributes to those who deny that God exists?
- d) In what ways, if ever, do you doubt God's existence? Why?
- e) What results does this Psalm say come from denying God's existence?
- f) What does this Psalm see as the solution to this problem?
- g) What can you actively and deliberately do in order to help bring about the answer to the prayer in v6?
