Tough Question 7 - How can I cope with suffering?

1) Is/was your view of mental suffering different from other sufferings? How personally have you been affected by mental suffering?
2) Read Matthew 8 v 23-27 (disciples caught in a violent storm) and Matthew 15 v 21-28 (the Canaanite woman) What encouraged your expectation / faith / trust most of all in what was said in Michel's message?
a) Can you give personal examples of times when you showed 'little faith' or great faith'?
b) Read Hebrews 11 v 6, 8-11, 17-19. Where would you place on a scale 1 to 10 (10 being 'great faith') your faith in God and in the power of God?
3) a) Have you come across a Christian who believes that God never intervenes in our suffering but let us go right through it?
b) What interaction did you have with the Christian holding this view?
4) a) Have you ever felt disappointed or guilty because of the lack of God's intervention in your suffering?
b) Read 1 Samuel 13/23 to 14/15 (especially verse 6) Were the comments on the 'inevitability of the will of God' helpful? How?
c) Pead Pomans 4 v 16 to 25 (verse 21 in particular). What did you make of the 'necessity of the word of God'?

DIGGING DEEPER

Read Matthew 26 v 36-56 with 2 Peter 4 v 12-19.

- a) Write down all the ways these two passages help us to cope with our suffering.
- b) Write down all the things you personally could do to help you when suffering arrives.
