3) Read the passage <u>2 Peter 3v3-15</u>. The phrase 'the last days' (<u>v3</u>) in the Bible always refers to the time between Jesus' first coming and his final return, rather than the time just before his final return. So this passage is talking about people now.

a) i) Why does this passage say people don't believe Jesus will return?

ii) Why does it say God is taking a long time?

iii) What do you think $\underline{v10}$ means when it says the day 'will come like a thief'?

b) This passage says that the fact of Jesus' return should affect the way we live now.

i) In what ways should it affect our life now?

ii) Why does Jesus' return mean we should live in this way?

<u>v12</u> and <u>v14</u> say we are to 'look forward' to the day of Jesus' return. iii) Why should Christians eagerly look forward to Jesus' return? What mustn't stop us looking forward eagerly?

iv) How does this passage suggest people who are not Christians should feel about Jesus' return? Why?

v) What specific changes do you personally need to make in your life?

c) i) What doubts or concerns do you personally have about Jesus' return?

ii) Is there anything you could do or someone you could talk to, to help address your doubts or concerns?

4) Digging Deeper Question – for those who want to study a bit extra

Re-read 2 Peter 3v3-15

a) What Biblical event do you think v6 refers to?
Rich said that in the Bible 'types' are like mini-previews of events or people.
b) In what ways could this event be a 'type' of the final day of the Lord?
c) What other Old Testament events could be seen as types of day of the Lord? Why?
d) What do you think is the significance of 'fire' in v7, v10 and v12?
Talking about Jesus' return, v12 says that we can 'speed its coming'.
e) How do you think we can do that?
